## eFreight – a brief guide

eFreight replaces the old paper documents that have been in use in the air cargo industry for decades, with standardized electronic messages and regulated data exchange.

# **Benefits of eFreight**

## eFreight components

### **Electronic freight documents**



The electronic airway bill (eAWB) being an electronic message, constitutes the legal basis for the transport agreement between freight forwarder and airline and is the first major digitized document.




The IATA standard electronic consignment security declaration (eCSD) is the digital equivalent to the regular paper-security and eCSD screening information of shipments.



The electronic house manifest (eHM) replaces paper house manifest or consol manifest with electronic messages (FHL or XFZB).



The electronic dangerous goods declaration (eDGD) is a new, digital standard for the management of dangerous goods data throughout the supply chain.

## **Process acceleration**



**PreCheck** is the preceded, electronic document processing of AWB and HAWB data belonging to an eAWB shipment through Lufthansa Cargo, resulting in **PreCheck** immediate response about their content quality.
